**Uniform Expectations 2026**

As we began our new term, we have noticed some students have returned not meeting the expected standards of uniform. We wanted to take the opportunity to communicate and re-enforce our uniform expectations. We will be having standards assemblies with each year group on Wednesday 7th January to reinforce this message and check he uniform expectations below.

**We ask for your continued support in ensuring uniform expectations are upheld:**

- During the winter months, we would encourage all students to arrive to school in an **outdoor coat**. Please note that **hoodies (including zip hoodies), denim jackets and tracksuits tops** are not permitted to be worn on the school grounds. Please reiterate to your child that **coats must be removed before entering the school building and shirts must be tucked in**.
- If your child decides to wear a black jumper for extra warmth, this must be a **plain black V neck jumper**, with no additional branding or patterns.
- Students are to wear formal, smart, black leather or patent shoes. **Students are not permitted to wear trainers or other canvas footwear**. Please see the parent/carers guide (<https://www.campion.warwickshire.sch.uk/uniform-policy>) for further guidance on uniform expectations.
- In addition to the uniform expectations outlined above, we have noticed an increase in students wearing star-shaped stickers to cover spots (Hydro-Stars). We ask that students refrain from using these stickers, as they are not part of the school uniform and can undermine the professional and consistent appearance we expect. Hydro-Stars are most effectively used overnight.
- Jewellery is restricted to one small plain metal stud in each ear lobe. No facial piercings, such as nose studs, or stretcher-style piercings are allowed. **Nose studs will be banned for all years including year 11 September 2026**
- Fake eyelashes and nail extensions are not permitted.
- Hair accessories such as bows, flowers and wide bands are not permitted, thin 'Alice bands' may be worn. Only natural hair dyes are permitted - this also includes hair extensions or braids. **Hair should be no shorter than grade 1 and no design lines/patterns are allowed.**

From **Monday 12th January**, any pupil who does not meet the school's uniform expectations will be issued a **break or lunchtime detention with their form tutor**. Should a pupil fail to attend this detention, the matter will be **escalated to a 2 hour Head detention**.

These sanctions will remain in place **until the pupil is fully compliant with the school uniform policy**.

We appreciate your continued support in ensuring that pupils attend school correctly dressed and ready to learn.
