

Year 13 A Level Sociology



1. Beliefs in Society

This unit will focus on issues and debates surrounding Beliefs in Society. Students will focus on theories of religion, secularization, renewal and choice, global context, movements and members and ideology and science.



2. Sociological Theories

This unit will focus on sociological theories developed to explain the social world. This will include; Functionalism, Marxism, Feminism, Action theories and Postmodernism. It also covers debates around objectivity, sociology as a science and the role of Sociology in social Policy.



3. Assessment Window 1

Students will consolidate all content from Beliefs in Society and Families and Households, completing a mock on A Level Sociology Paper 2: Research methods and topics in sociology.



5. Sociological Methods

This unit will focus on the methods used to investigate and test social theories. Methods include; experiments, interviews, questionnaires, official statistics, documents, observations and their theoretical, ethical and practical strengths and limitations .



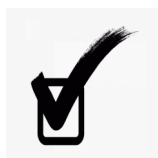
4. Crime and Deviance

This unit will focus on issues and debates surrounding crime and deviance. Students will focus on theories of crime and deviance, gender and ethnicity and crime, the role of media, globalization, state, green and human rights crime and control punishments and victims.



6. Assessment Window 2

Students will consolidate all content from Crime and Deviance and Theory and Methods, completing a mock on A Level Sociology Paper 3: Crime and deviance with theory and methods.



7. A Level Revision

Students will consolidate all content from Paper 1, Paper 2 and Paper 3; this will involve repetition using class notes, as well as the completion of mock exams and timed essay questions.



8. Exam Preparations and Boosters

Students will receive a series of booster lessons ahead of scheduled exams, as well as revision opportunities which will cover content across Paper 1,2 and 3, preparing them for their final examinations.
